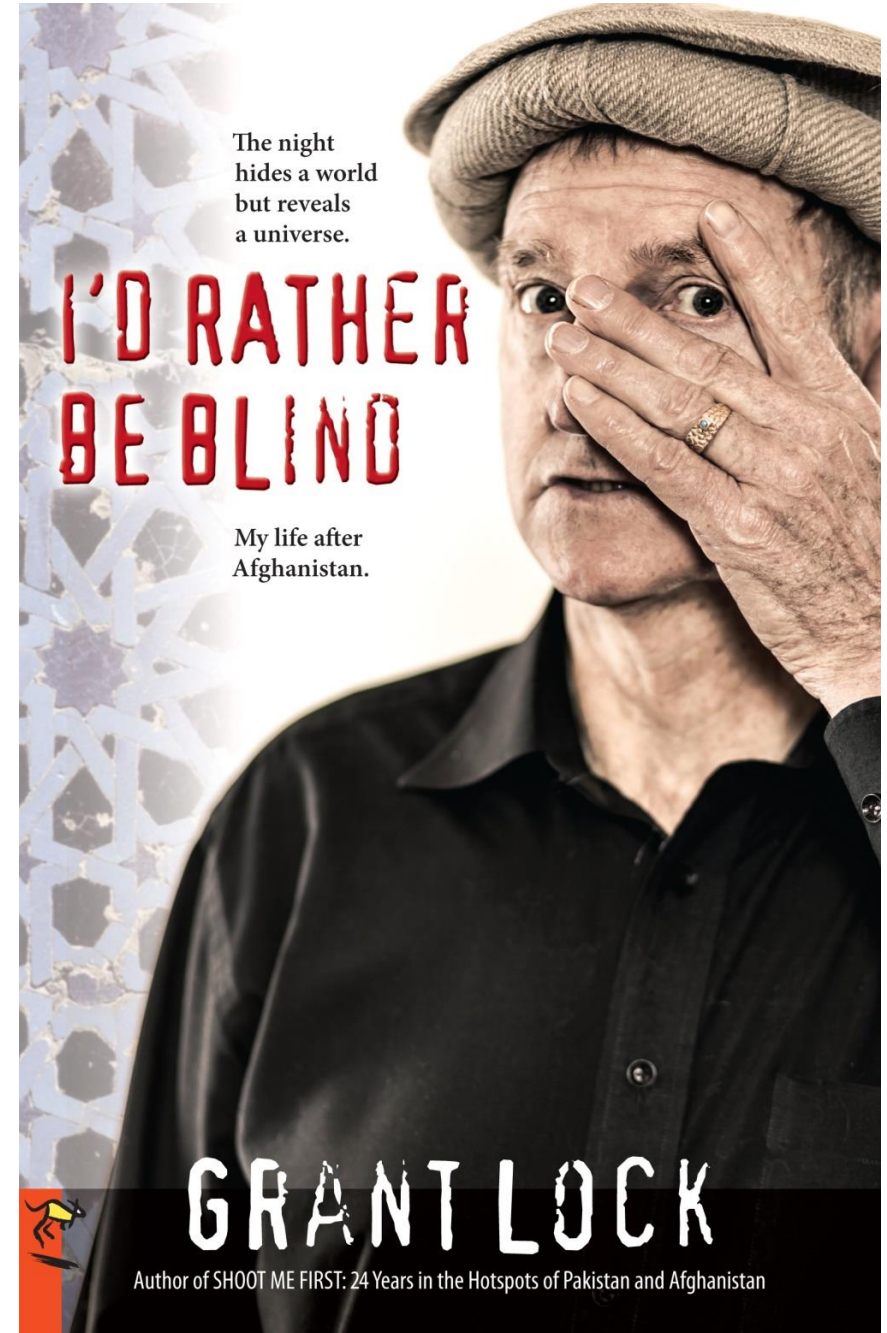












2001, to 2021

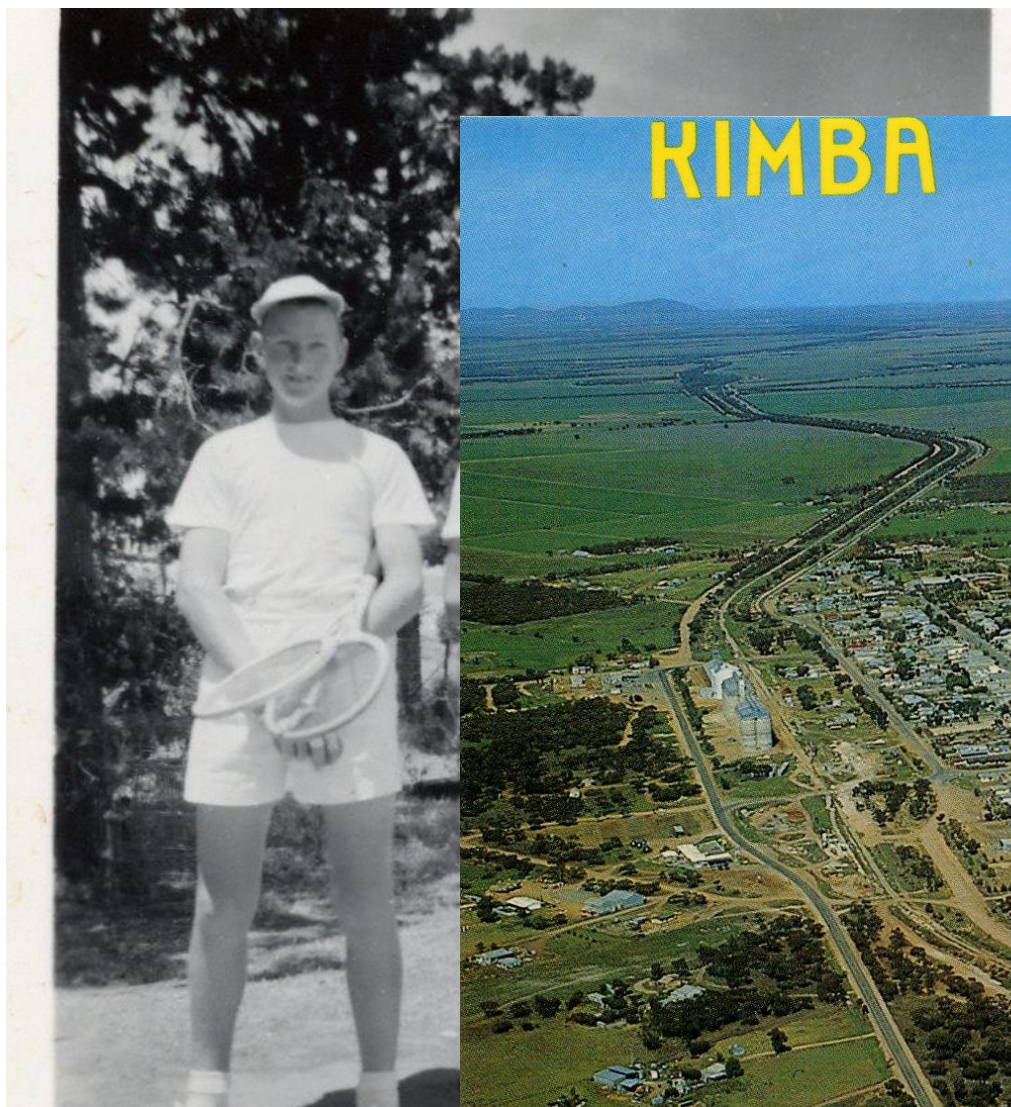

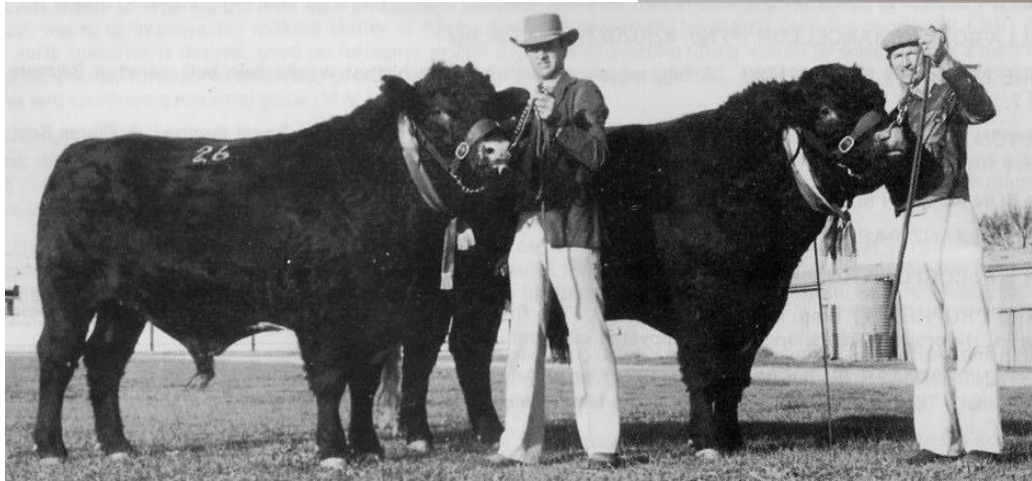

HISTORY OF KIMBA (RAINFALL 340mm)

IN LONG TIME AGO, IN 1808, THE FIRST PERMANENT SETTLERS SOWED THE FIRST GRAIN & GREW THE HARVEST. LONG BEFORE THE E.L. EYRE HAD SKIRTED THE AREA ON HIS JOURNEYS OF THE LANDS OF THE PANGKALA ABORIGINAL PEOPLE FOR WHOM THE SMALL SPRINGS, GOMAGES & ROCKPOLES WERE THEIR SEASONAL FOODS FROM THE COAST.

IN 1800'S STRONG OVERSEAS WHEAT MARKETS & A DEMAND FOR ADDITIONAL FARMING LAND BY THE SETTLERS OF GOMING FARMERS LED TO THE OPENING UP OF THE LAST OF THE LANDS FOR AGRICULTURE.

VISIBLE CROPS WERE SOWN ON NATURAL PLAINS, WHILE "LOGGERS" WITH THEIR TEAMS OF HORSES, CLEARING THE MALLEE SCRUB, & AXEMEN "MULLENIZED" THE STANDS OF NATIVE OAK, RETAINING THE BEST TIMBERS FOR FENCING & BUILDING.

WHEN THE RAILWAY FROM PORT LINCOLN WAS EXTENDED TO THE NEW SIDING, THE PIONEERS OBTAINED THEIR MAIL & SUPPLIES FROM COWELL OVER EDOON.

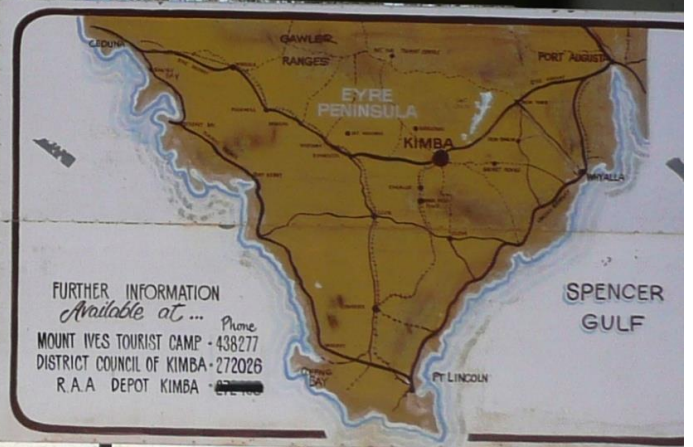
THE ISOLATION WAS MUCH RELIEVED BY THE ADVENT OF THE RAILWAY WHICH BROUGHT COMMUNICATION WITH THE OUTSIDE WORLD. THE PROCLAMATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KIMBA, CONCURRED WITH THE INFUX OF SETTLERS TO THE NEW AREA, & BOOSTED CONFIDENCE IN THE DISTRICT.

BUSINESSMEN OF ALL KINDS WERE ATTRACTED TO THE TOWN & COMMUNITY WORKED TOGETHER TO PROVIDE SOCIAL, EDUCATIONAL, MEDICAL & ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES. IN 1920 THE RAILWAY WAS EXTENDED TO BUCKLEBOO.

PROGRESS WAS RESTORED WITH INCREASING PRICES FOR WOOL & WHEAT. THE INFUX OF MORE RECENT DEVELOPMENTS BULK GRAIN SILOS DOMINATE THE SIDING TRUCKS ONCE STOOD & THE PIPELINE BRINGS AN ASSURED WATER SUPPLY TO THE BASIN.

IN FEW DECADES OF KIMBA'S HISTORY HAVE BEEN INFLUENCED BY THE CHANGING MARKETS BUT MOST OF ALL BY THE SPIRIT OF CO-OPERATION OF THE DISTRICT.

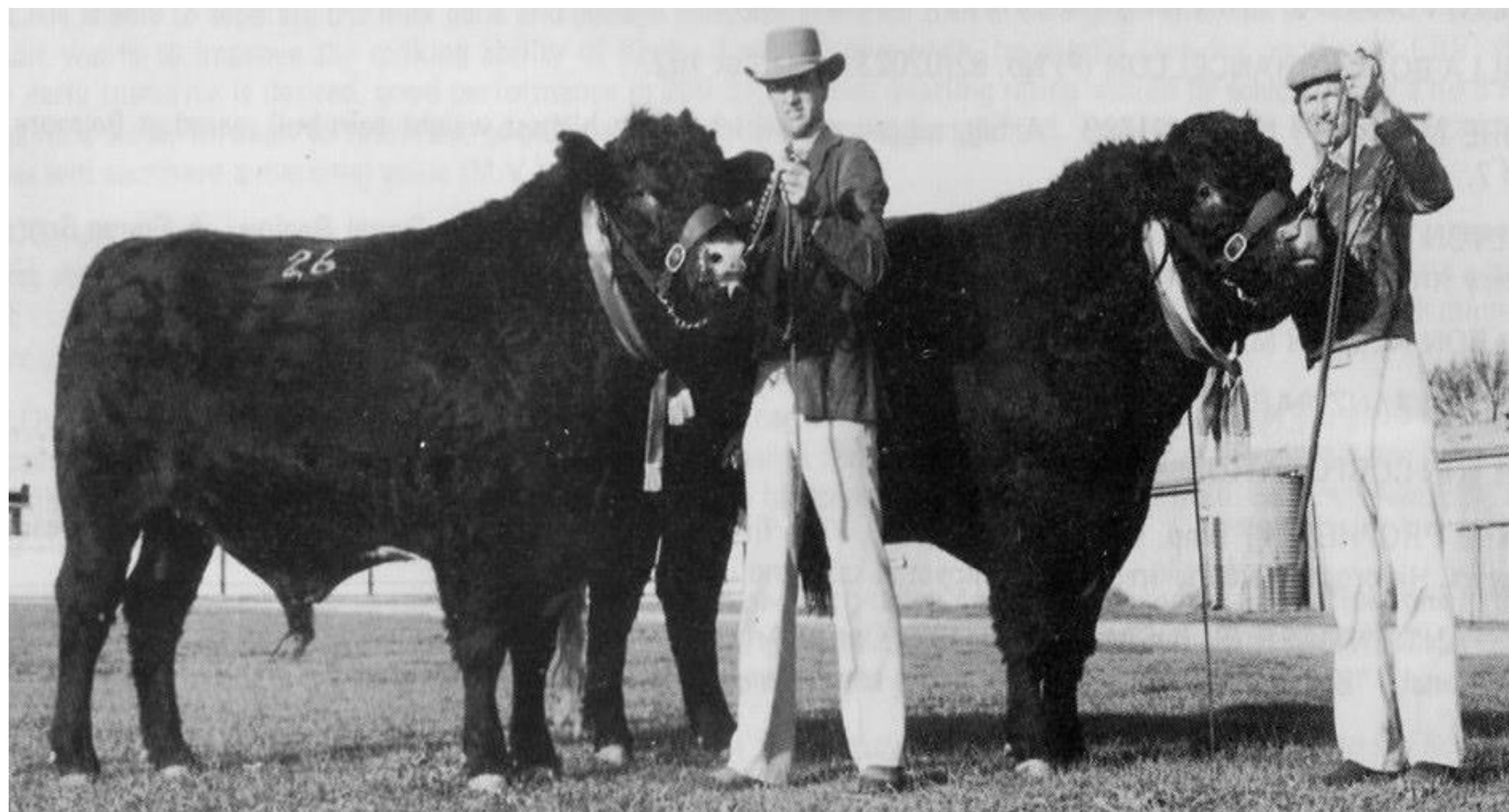
