





Timeline

2022

24 December

My journey to travel to Antarctica and the South Atlantic begins. At Melbourne airport I checked in one red suitcase for travel to Buenos Aires

I travel QF418 Melbourne to Sydney

LA800 Sydney to Santiago, Chile

LA477 Santiago to Buenos Aires

On arrival at Buenos Aires my suitcase was not available. A tracker in the suitcase showed it to be in Sydney. I reported the suitcase as missing. A case number EZELA99177 was established.

I stayed one night at the CasaSur Recoletal hotel in Buenos Aires.

25 December

I travel: AR1890 Buenos Aires to Ushuaia

25 December to 27 December

I stayed three nights at Las Hayas Resort Hotel in Ushuaia, having only the clothes I was wearing when I flew from Melbourne, which are quite inadequate for the cold weather. Attempts to have suitcase transported to Ushuaia come to nothing.

27 December

I go shopping in Ushuaia for replacement clothing, a backpack, and toiletries in Ushuaia. Total cost in Australian dollars: \$2,327.30. Also, some kind people loan and give me some spare clothes.

28 December 2022 to 16 January 2023

I travel on the *Greg Mortimer* to Stanley (in the Falkland Islands), South Georgia, and the Antarctic Peninsula. While aboard the *Greg Mortimer* I use the tracker to check my suitcase location daily. It remains at Sydney airport. A kind person on board gives me a small old suitcase.

16 January

I disembark from the Greg Mortimer.

I travel: AR1891 Ushuaia to Buenos Aires.

I stay one night at the CasaSur Recoletal hotel in Buenos Aires.

17 January

I travel: LA652 Buenos Aires to Santiago.

The tracker shows the suitcase location as the Sunshine Coast airport at Maroochydore, Queensland.

19 January

The tracker shows the suitcase location as Melbourne airport. A courier contacts my wife in Melbourne to arrange delivery of the suitcase to my home address: 7 Chloris Crescent, Caulfield VIC.

20 January to 21 January

I travel: LA801 Santiago to Auckland

21 January

I travel: QF154 Auckland to Melbourne.

On arrival at my home I find the suitcase on the porch beside the front door.
